

Qualified Clinical Data Registry/Qualified Registry

The Doctors' Quality Reporting Network (DQRN), sponsored by KONZA, is a CMS-approved Qualified Clinical Data Registry (QCDR) and Qualified Registry (QR) for MIPS reporting for 2019. The DQRN can manually submit data for 44 Electronic Clinical Quality Measures (eCQMs). These 2015 ONC and Drummond-certified measures are standardized and intended to provide reliable indicators of high quality patient care. DQRN can also submit data for 232 measures via 35 different specialty sets via a direct EHR report. The metrics cover management of chronic diseases, preventive care screening, use of appropriate medications, and overall cost of care reductions. These indicators are required elements of the CMS Quality Payment Program.

In order to have KONZA prepare your 2019 quality reports and submit them via the DQRN registry you need to:

- Participate in the KONZA health information exchange.
- Determine if you will report as an individual or as part of a group.
- Determine which measures you plan to report on for 2019.
- Determine if you would like to also report your Promoting Interoperability and Improvement Activities to streamline reporting.
- Retrieve your measures report from your EHR.
- Confirm the use of 2015 Certified EHR Technology (CEHRT).

OCTOBER 1 QCDR or QR purchase order signed for all MIPS categories.
